Abstracts

Most abstracts have been received. Please review your submission and send in any an updated version, if you want a modified text to appear. The text submitted in the abstract is very important as this will be the only printed information available during the NDE2002 seminar. Full papers on CD/internet. In some cases, the abstracts submitted were not found suitable for printing (Reasons: Title and table of contents only, complete papers without abstract or graphically elaborate power point projections) Please ensure that your abstract contains the following information as **text matter**:

Title of the paper

Author(s)

Author affiliation (university, intitute, company)

Contact address and/or e-mail of the corresponding author or presenting author.

Abstract text, length of up to one A4 page.

Full text of papers (before November 1, 2002)

Full papers will be published on a CD and on the internet, if the papers reach in time for publication (not later than November 1). **Specifications for the full paper are flexible**, since there is no restriction on the length of the full paper for CD publication. We recommend the length to be between one page and fifteen pages, if it was printed. The material will be included in the conference CD. Advertising material is not acceptable as a technical paper.

FULL TEXT FORMAT for papers and posters

Title of the paper

Contact address or e-mail of the corresponding author /presenting author.

Full text including, tables, figures, illustrations and references

The material has to reach in a text formattable form, ASCII text or word document (.doc), but **not** in graphical form (gif, jpg or pdf) or power point presentations (pps, .ppt). Illustrations may be embedded in word files or can be sent separately as .gif or .jpg files. The resolution should not be larger than 600 x 800 pixel. Tables and equations can be included.

Presentation time

Time available for presentations during the Seminar is 20 minutes for contributed papers and 30 minutes for invited papers. Please leave about three minutes for discussion time.

Audiovisual equipment, a microphone, overhead projection, 35mm slide projection and LED (power point) will be available in the seminar halls. Please inform us which media you plan to use.

Biodata. Please send your Short Biodata quoting your paper number. The session chairperson will introduce the authors. This also applies to authors of the poster session.
